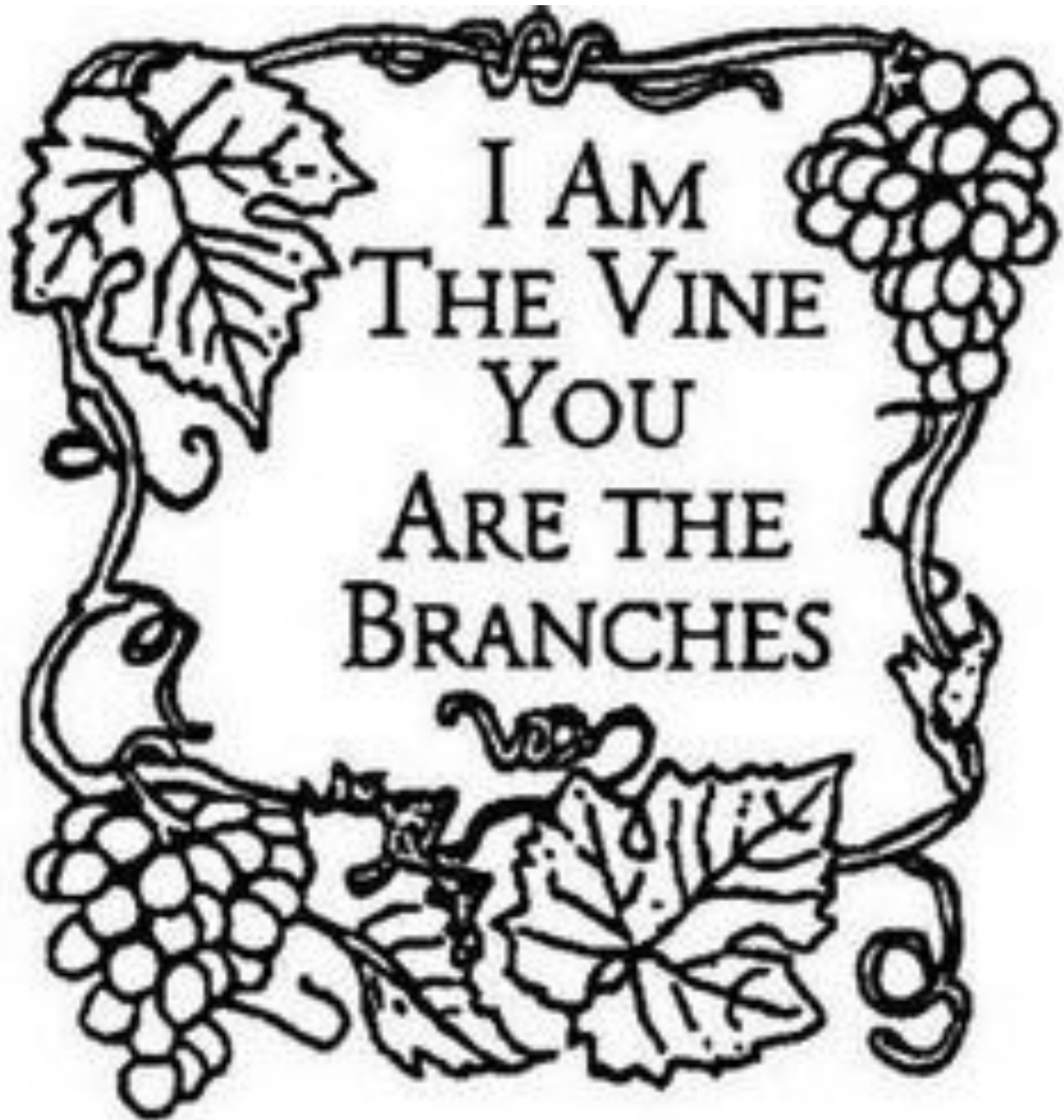
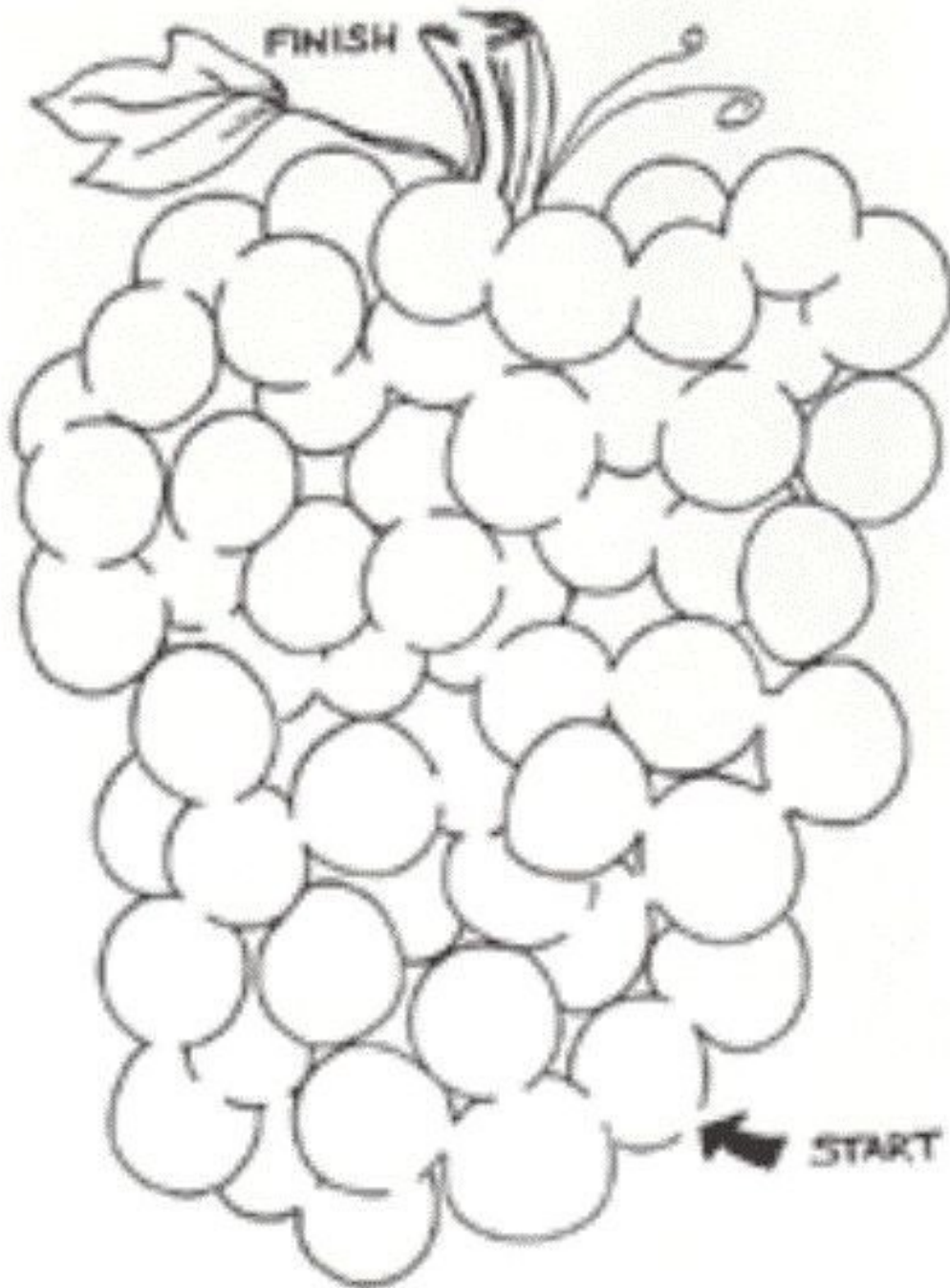


May 2, 2021
Fifth Sunday of Easter



Did you know that Jesus talked about grapes? Many people in Jesus' day had vineyards where they grew grapes. Jesus said that He was the vine, and that we are the branches. What does that mean? Jesus was explaining how important it is for us to stay connected to Him. Just as the vine provides nutrition that helps fruit (like a grape) grow on a plant, Jesus gives us all that we need to grow in our faith. The branches on a grape vine have to stay connected to the vine so that they can produce fruit. Otherwise, they'll dry up and wither and become raisins. If we walk away and abandon faith, we'll shrivel up just like a grape.
